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The Board was following the consent validity period under Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981 as per the notifications cited under reference (2) & (3). Further, the Board in its 195th Meeting held on 24.01.2015, approved to revise the validity period of Consent for Operation under the Water Act, 1974 & the Air Act, 1981 in respect of large/medium Red and Orange categories industries/organizations uniformly. Accordingly, CFO of five years was prescribed for large/medium Red and Orange category vide Notification cited under reference (5). This notification was kept in abeyance vide Office Memorandum cited under reference (6) as some of the Board Members expressed their dissent to the resolution dated 24.1.2015 in the above subject matter.

Further, in the 198th Board Meeting, the Board reviewed the 195th Board Meeting resolution and modified it with respect to prescribing consent validity period to one year only for large & medium red category industries. The excess consent fee paid by large red category industries/organizations shall be refunded on case to case basis and an order to this effect was issued vide reference (7) after the receipt of the proceedings,

The Board in its 199th Meeting held on 8.9.2015 again reviewed the decision of 198th Board Meeting reg. consent validity period issued under the Water Act, 1974 and the Air Act, 1981 in respect of large/medium red category industries/organization and approved to modify the Board Meeting resolution with respect to prescribing consent validity period as under:

"The validity of consent for operation under the Water and Air Act is restricted to one year only with respect to large red category".

Hence, the following

ORDER


- 1) The validity period of consent for operation under the Water and the Air Act is restricted to one year only in respect of large red category industries/organization.
- 2) Accordingly, the CFO validity period in respect of large/medium/small/micro Red, Orange and Green categories shall be as under:

Category	Consent Validity Period		
	Red	Orange	Green
Large	1 year (1 fee)	2 years (2 fees)	10 years (5 fees)
Medium	2 years (2 fees)	2 years (2 fees)	10 years (5 fees)
Small	5 years (3 fees)	5 years (3 fees)	10 years (1 fee)
Micro (<25 laksh)	5 years (1 fee)	5 years (1 fee)	One time permanent consent (1 fee)

- 3) The consent validity prescribed in respect of Health Care Establishments vide Reference No.(1) remains unaltered.
- 4) Consent fee paid by industries/organization in compliance to notification at reference (5) shall be considered for one year consent & the excess fee shall be returned to the respective industries/organizations.

The above order supersedes all other orders in respect of consent validity period issued earlier.
