NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the Powers conferred by section 64 of The Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, (Central Act-6 of 1974) and in consultation with the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board, the Government of Karnataka hereby makes the following rules further to amend The Karnataka State Pollution Control Board for Prevention and Control of Water Pollution (Procedure for Transaction of Business) and The Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Rules 1976, namely:-

1. **Title and commencement:** - These rules may be called the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board for Prevention and Control of Water Pollution (Procedure for Transaction of Business) and The Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) (Amendment) Rules 2015.

2. They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

3. **Amendment of Rule 15:-** The Karnataka State Pollution Control Board for Prevention and Control of Water Pollution (Procedure for Transaction of Business) and the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Rules, 1976, hereinafter referred to as the said rule, for the rule 15 the following shall be substituted:

4. **15. Powers and Duties of the Chairman:-** The Chairman shall have the following powers and duties, namely;

1. To exercise powers and functions as may be delegated by the State Board;
2. The Chairman may tour within or outside State to carry out the purposes of the Act;

Provided that no tour outside India shall be under taken without the approval of the State Government ”.

4. **Amendment of Rule 16:-** For rule 16 of the said rules, the following shall be substituted, namely :

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"16. Powers and Duties of the Member Secretary:- The Member Secretary shall have the following powers and duties, namely;

1. To conduct day to day Business and the administrative control over the staff of the State Board;
2. Shall be in charge of all the confidential papers of the State Board and shall be responsible for preserving them;
3. Shall produce such papers whenever so directed by the State Board;
4. Shall make available to any Member of the State Board for his perusal, any record of the State Board;
5. Shall make all arrangements for holding meetings of the State Board and Meetings of the Committees constituted by the State Board;
6. To give administrative sanction to estimates included in the Budget of the State Board with the prior approval of the State Board;
7. To accept tenders as per the Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurement Act, 1999 / Rules there under in each case and in accordance with the power delegated by the State Board and also refunds if any, relating to tenders shall be returned as per the provisions of the Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurement Act, 1999 / Rules there under;
8. Shall have powers to give technical sanction to the estimates approved by the State Board;
9. Shall make appointments, promotions, transfers and other conditions as per the Cadre and Recruitment and conditions of Service Regulations of the Board with the prior approval of the Board and the State Government;
10. Shall be entitled to call for the services of any officer or employee of the State Board, files, papers and documents for study from any Department of State Board as also to carry out inspection of any Branch at any time including checking of accounts, vouchers, bills and other records and stores pertaining to the State Board or Regional officers there under;
11. All orders or instructions to be issued by the State Board shall be under the seal and signature of the Member Secretary;
12. Shall write and maintain confidential reports of officials and staff of the State Board and shall get them counter signed by the Chairman;
13. May tour within or outside State to carry out the purposes of the Act, Provided that no tour outside India shall be under taken without the approval of the State Government;

14. Shall exercise such other powers and perform such other functions as may be delegated to him from time to time by the State Board”.
