OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub : Issue of consent to Coffee pulping activities and increasing the consent validity period – reg.

Ref : Proceedings of 201st Board Meeting held on 01.12.2015.

Coffee pulping is a seasonal activity and pulpers are mainly located in the country side within the coffee estates. They are significant from water pollution point of view and categorized as Orange Category. The Board has started receiving and processing the Orange category industries/organizations consent applications online through XGN software since November 2015. Since the majority of the pulpers are small and tiny; and located in the country-side, it may be difficult to pursue them to update the profile in the XGN software at present.

Further, it is felt that longer consent validity period for pulping activity would help in focusing more time for enforcement activities as the number of pulpers to be covered in the consent mechanism is increasing. The above aspects were discussed in the 201st Board Meeting and resolved to continue with the consent procedure manually and increase of consent validity period. Hence, the following.

ORDER

- (i) Jurisdictional Regional Officers shall continue to receive consent applications, process them and issue consent manually for coffee pulping activities. Company estate consent applications shall be processed in 'XGN software'.

- (ii) All other conditions for control of water pollution as stipulated earlier remains unchanged.

This order comes into force with immediate effect and until further orders.
