

PROCEEDINGS OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL PUBLIC HEARING HELD ON 03.12.2013 AT 11:00 AM IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROPOSED INDUSTRIAL AREA DEVELOPMENT IN AN EXTENT OF 1167.12 HACTRES (2884.15 ACRES) AS 2ND AND 3RD STAGE OF VASANTHANARASAPURA INDUSTRIAL AREA, TUMKUR TALUK & DISTRICT

M/s Karnataka Industrial Area Development Board, has proposed to develop Vasanthanarasapura 2nd and 3rd Stage of industrial area of at Tumkur Taluk and District in an area of 2884.15 Acres. The KIADB authorities have applied for Environmental Clearance as per the EIA Notification-2006, from the Ministry of Forests and Environment, Government of India. Accordingly, the MOEF has given letter containing Terms of reference (TOR) vide letter No. F.No. 21-67/2012-IA-III and project proponent vide letter dated 19.09.2013 requested the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board to conduct Environmental Public Consultation / Public Hearing as per the EIA Notification, 2006 and to submit the minutes of the Proceedings.

As per the guidelines stipulated in the EIA Notification, the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board has initiated action and has arranged for this meeting. The Board has issued the paper Notification dated 02.11.2013 in leading News papers "Deccan Herald (English) "Vijaya Karnataka"(Kannada) and "Prajapragathi" in the local Kannada daily for publicity. Local Grama Panchayath Office viz., Thimmarajanahalli, Nelahalu & Kesthuru were contacted and informed about public hearing and also to facilitate local residents, Environmentalist and publics who are directly and indirectly affected by the project to submit their objections through E-Mail/ in writing /to the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board / Presiding Officer, Environmental

Public Hearing Committee (Deputy Commissioner, Tumkur District, Tumkur) or orally during the Public Hearing.

As per the Environmental Impact Assessment Notification 2006, the Public Hearing was conducted at Project site on 03.12.2013 at 11:00 AM under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, Tumkur. The representatives of State Pollution Control Board Regional Senior Environmental Officer, Chitradurga, assisted in conducting the meeting. Sri. B.S. Murulidhara, Environmental Officer, Tumkur, Welcomed Deputy Commissioner, Sri. H.P. Mukunda Krishnegowda, Joint Director, District Industries and Commerce, Tumkur. Sri. K.C. Shivakumar, Development Officer, KIADB, Tumkur. Sri. Ravi M. Tirlapur, Special Land Acquisition Officer, Publics, Media Persons and all other representatives from different organization. He informed the public gathered to express their views on the proposed project. The presiding officer then directed the representative of KIADB to make presentation on the project including environmental issues.

Sri. K.C. Shivakumar, Development Officer, KIADB, Tumkur informed that M/s Ramkey Enviro Engineers Pvt Ltd. Bangalore has prepared detailed environmental impact assessment study of the area and make presentation. Sri. Hemanth Kumar representing M/s Ramkey Enviro Engineers Pvt Ltd. Bangalore explained the publics, officials from different organization regarding development works through power point presentation. He also explained about the land use pattern pertaining to 2nd and 3rd Stage Vasanthanarasapura Industrial Area, covering villages Kempanadodderi (50.60), Nagenahalli (68.40), Bathsandra (112.00), Kenchenahalli (19.83), Vasanthnarasapura (22.27), Yaladalu (434.00), Sangenahalli (140.63), Thippedasarahalli (150.20), Buvajanahalli (100.00), Doddanapalya (4.45) and Kempadalihalli (4.10) Total extent 1106.51 Ha and the land use pattern in the 2nd and 3rd Stage as follows

After the presentation was completed, the Deputy Commissioner informed the KIADB authorities to submit plan of action for the following :-

- Plantation Proposed in the 1st, 2nd & 3rd Stage of Vasanthanarasapura and the amount reserved for Green development.
- Employment opportunity to the local publics
- Noise Pollution control measures proposed.
- Rain water harvesting facility and structures proposed.
- Common solid waste disposal site area marked is less and inform to verify.
- Establishment of Health Care facility in the industrial area
- Establishment of Fire station in the industrial area.

Further the Regional Officer, KSPCB, to ensure that the industries should comply with water Act, Air Act and Hazardous waste rules. For establishment of Red Category industries in 2nd and 3rd stage utmost care should be taken to ensure pollution prevention. The projects covered under EIA notification should be monitored and progress made on implementation of corporate responsibility for environmental protection to be reported. The half yearly meeting shall be organized in the industrial area with local publics on environmental related issues. Separate environmental cell shall be established to look after the environmental issues in Vasanthanarasapura Industrial Area.

Presiding Officer requested the publics gathered in the meeting to submit their representations, objections / grievances / advices related to the proposed industrial area

developed by Karnataka Industrial Area Development Board. Accordingly following public has expressed their views:

1) **Sri. Hanumantaiah, Bathsandra village, Kora(H), Tumkur (Dist.)**

He stated that the concerned officer has not informed the local villagers regarding Public Hearing, Sri B.S. Muralidhara, Environmental Officer informed that the paper notification is published in the Vijaya Karnataka and Deccan herald on 02.11.2013 and in Praja pragati local news paper on 27.11.2013. Further the concerned Grama Panchayats were informed about the Public Hearing through Regional Office, Tumkur letter dated 07/11/2013 and also abstract of REIA report in Kannada is placed in the Grama Panchayat Office viz., Timmarajanahalli, Nelahalu & keshuru for Public reference. Further he informed that more publicity will be given on Public Hearing in the local villages henceforth.

2) **Sri Jagadish, Kodihalli, Tumkur.**

He reported that the local farmers are not aware of Public Hearing. Further he highlighted the pollution at 1st phase Vasanthanarasapura Industrial Area i.e., disposal of industrial waste. Deputy Commissioner informed the Environmental Officer to visit the site and to take action immediately. Sri Jagadish enquired on the species of plant proposed in 1st Phase and he requested to entrust the work of green belt development and he assured to develop as a model in the Industrial area. He also requested to plantation done in 1st Phase Vasanthanarasapura Industrial Area. The development Officer of KIADB Informed that Rs. 29 lakhs reserved for the plantation work and will be entrusted to Forest Department with one year maintenance. Sri Ravi M Tirlapur informed that Government has already paid compensation for the trees coming under the proposed industrial area development project. However if the trees are not considered for compensation will be verified and sorted out.

3) **Sri Siddalingaiah, Yelladodlu, Kora Hobli, Tumkur (dist).**

He reported that there is no approach road to the village due to development of industrial area. KIADB Authorities have not left the existing road which are used by the public. Due to

developmental works from the KIADB, dust is generated and they have not provided water sprinkling arrangement to suppress the dust. This dust accumulated on the surrounding plants causing problems to the domestic animals. Deputy Commissioner informed the farmers to submit the complaint on the above said issue. In response to the above KIADB authorities clarified that the existing roads were not disturbed as ear marked in the village map.

4) Sri Jagadish, Grama Panchayath member, Tumkur.

Reported that M/s. S.R. Constructions have dug 8 new Bore wells at survey No. 34 and 46 for development of housing facility for their workers. This resulted in depletion of the ground water table in the surrounding agriculture land. Further he reported that the KIADB officials are not properly responding to the public problems. So far compensation for land acquisition is not paid. Hence he requested the Deputy Commissioner to pay the compensation amount through Deputy Commissioner Office. Further he requested not to acquire the farmers land which is left in the notification. Smt. K.V. Lilavathi, Asst. Engineer, KIADB reported that the bore wells are drilled for housing purpose proposed in KIADB Industrial area.

5) Sri. V.N. Murthy, Z.P. Member, Nelahal.

He reported that 1300 Hectares of land is acquired out of which 700 Hectares reserved for Industrial purposes. Most of the farmers have lost their agriculture land. The disposal of industrial solid waste and pollution from the industrial activity should be highlighted to the villagers. He requested the payment to the farmers who have lost their land should enroute through the Deputy Commissioner to the land owners. The land acquired at Tippedasarahalli has to be deleted from the land acquisition, since the most of the land in coming in that village limit.



6) Sri Hanumantappa, Haldodderi, Tumkur.

Reported that most of the farmers land acquired and the compensation is yet to be paid to the farmers in Vasanthanarasapura 1st, 2nd and 3rd phase and also requested to delete the areas where buildings are existing. Further he requested to adopt rain water harvesting and employment to the local people.

Deputy Commissioner concluded that Compensation to the land acquired as per the Law will be dealt fairly. Co-operation between public, land owners and officials is very much necessary and also harmony among them for success of industrial area and he requested land owners to submit the representation to District Administration with in a week for needful

Public gathered in the meeting submitted representations to the Presiding officer. Compensation related matter referred to special land acquisition officers and KIADB Officials.

Finally the hearing was ended with vote of thanks by Sri. Ravi M. Tirlapur, Special Land Special Acquisition Officer, to all the participants attended the meeting.
