NOTIFICATION

Sub: Guidelines for siting of Slaughter House.

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Preamble:

The CPCB has already framed guidelines for slaughter houses and also its location. Further, Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Slaughter House) Rules 2001 is also notified in this regard. The CPCB guideline stipulates the location. However in some of the cases slaughter house are being proposed near to the Municipal Solid Waste Site and suggestions are sought by the Board.

Therefore the subject has been discussed both at the technical advisory committee, Authorization committee and in the Board meeting cited under the above references and The following guidelines are evolved for establishing the slaughter house.

ORDER

The site selection for establishing the slaughter house shall be recommended as follows:

1. The slaughter houses shall be treated like food industries.
2. Similar to that, any industrial plant it should have proper treatment plant for waste water and control equipment for the Air emissions from the various sources.
3. The new slaughter house shall be located in accordance with the CPCB guidelines viz., the slaughter house should be located outside or on the periphery of the city/town and shall be away from the Airport. Main services such as water, electricity and waste disposal facility are prerequisite.

4. The slaughter houses shall be located preferably aerial distance of 1 Km away from solid waste management processing facility/ land fill site identified and not less than 500 mtrs away from Common waste facility like STP/ETP/CBMWTP, to prevent bird/ stray animals menace which are mainly responsible for spreading infectious during its roaming/migration.
5. The slaughter houses shall be provided with the green belt with at least 5 rows of plantation of tall trees all along the boundary.
6. The existing slaughter houses operating if any within the core area of the town/city shall provide treatment plant and control equipments and may discharge the effluent to the area specified in the consent issued by the KSPCB from time to time.

Further, waste from stand alone mutton and chicken stalls located in the area/ward in the towns creating nuisance to the waste pickers and the public. Hence, it is resolved to indicate this in the new country and town planning byelaws where standalone units shall be discouraged and a common place in each of the ward shall be designated. This would be easier for management to collect the waste and also for scientific disposal of various purposes like to Bone mills, Blood extraction units and/or disposal to landfill sites for the deep burial with half yearly composting (Design for treatment may be worked out separately).
