OFFICE MEMORANDUM

**Sub:** Monitoring of effluents, emissions, water quality etc., through Private Laboratories by Industries and Organisations.

In the 192<sup>nd</sup> Board Meeting held on 25.6.2014, the Board has dispensed with empanelment of Private laboratories. Accordingly, the Memorandum cited at ref.(2) was issued. The Board in its 195<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 24.1.2015 again deliberated on the need of informing the industries to avail the laboratory services from recognized laboratories under the Environment (Protection) Act and those laboratories having accreditation with National Accreditation Board for testing and calibration laboratories (NABL). Hence, the following;

- 1) The industries/organizations could get the surface/ground water, effluent, emissions, soil etc. tested through any of the laboratories recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and or those laboratories having accreditation with NABL.
- 2) Such recognized laboratories should have accreditation to analyse for parameters stipulated in the consent orders issued by the Board or for parameters stipulated for industry specific in the EP Rules, 1986.
- 3) While submitting the analysis reports to the Board, the industry/organization shall enclose the valid certified copies along with of scope of accreditation issued by the certifying agency of recognitions/accreditation.

However, the samples collected by the Board as per the provisions of Section 21 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 26 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and analysed at the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board's

Central Environmental Laboratory or Regional Laboratories or by the Government Analyst shall only be admissible in evidence in a legal proceedings.
